 - o If both participants have wrestled more than 20 matches, comparison will be based on win percentage.
- League Placer-Previous year

TOURNAMENT POINTS

The top six (6) placers in each weight class earn points at the following ratio:

WEIGH-IN:

- a. National Federation Wrestling Rules weigh-in procedures will be used at all WIAA Regional Tournaments.
- b. Electronic scales will be used for weigh-ins and should expedite the process.
- c. Officials will be available at the weigh-ins for skin checks. Officials will be at each scale. We will run at least two scales during weigh-in.
- d. There is a one pound weight allowance for a wrestler that advances from Friday to Saturday.

WARM-UPS

A mat room is available and is the designated warm-up area. There is also area adjacent to the match mats for warm up.

<u>OUALIFYING FOR REGIONALS</u>

Girl's Regional-Regionals will be held at Bellingham High School on February 15, 2014.

Mat Classic-Tacoma Dome- Fri/Sat, February 21 and 22, 2014. Top four placers from the Region 1 Tournament will advance to the State Tournament.

District One Event Supervisory Pass only and District 1/WIAA Lifetime passes are valid for admission. The school name must be printed/typed on the pass. <u>No other passes will be accepted!</u> Participants, coaches and support staff needs to be listed/typed on the participant's sheet provided. <u>This list needs to be completed and returned to the Burlington-Edison HS Athletic Office by 11:00 am, Tuesday, Feb. 4, 2014.</u>

PRESS- Members of the working media and press photographers who wish to cover the event will be admitted, but need to check-in at the pass gate with appropriate credentials.

<u>PROTESTS</u>

Any protest occurring at the tournament will be presented to Patrick Brown, the Tournament Director. He in turn will confer with the tournament committee. Decisions of the committee are final.

<u>AWARDS</u>

Individual First Place at each weight will receive a medal from WIAA District One. 2nd through 4th places will receive a ribbon. NO TEAM TROPHY will be award since this is a regional qualifier.

PROGRAMS/T-SHIRTS

Programs and t-shirts will be available at the Sub-Region #1 Tournament.

CONCESSIONS will be available.

CHEERLEADERS

Up to eight cheerleaders and their advisor will be admitted free. Please include on the list.

LOCKER ROOMS

Locker rooms will be provided. Individuals will need to provide their own towels and are expected to treat the facilities with care.

W.I.A.A. TOURNAMENT RULES

W.I.A.A. tournament rules will apply. (i.e. Sportsmanship, signs, noisemakers, floor restrictions, coaches in the corner and admissions.)

FLOOR RESTRICTIONS

This is a WIAA post-season event. Spectators will not be allowed in the wrestling areas.

- a. The west bleachers are assigned for spectators.
- **b.** The **east bleachers** will be reserved for teams and individual wrestlers.
- **c.** Only two coaches and a scorer per school at a mat. Wrestlers not wrestling may not sit in the coach's area. Passes will be issued to coaches and scorekeepers.
- **d.** Photographers and Video Cameras- <u>Will not be allowed on the mats.</u> Please inform parents that they will not be allowed to photograph in the wrestling area.

INJURED WRESTLERS

A wrestler removed from participation in a tournament match due to an injury, shall not be allowed to continue until authorized by the medical authority that made the original decision at that tournament, or his/her designee. Decisions by the medical authority are final.

W.I.A.A. EJECTION RULE

Wrestlers barred from all further competition (remainder of Sub-Regionals, and the Regional and State Tournament) if:

- 1. EJECTED FOR FIRST instance of Flagrant Misconduct (Federation Rule) OR
- 2. EJECTED FOR SECOND instance of Un-sportsmanlike Conduct (Federation Rule) of an "abusive" nature (W.I.A.A. standard).
