Tournament Entry:

The Northwest and Cascade Conference put into effect a reduced field for the 2015 & 2016 Boys and Girls District One Golf Tournament. The field will be reduced to only 70% of the entries from previous years into the district tournament from each conference.

Northwest Conference has 8 schools playing boys golf, Cascade Conference has 3 schools playing boys golf, and WESCO only one 2A school (Shorecrest). In previous years, each school would get 6 golfers for a total of 72 golfers in the field. This year, by reducing that number using the formula of 70% of the entries will result in a total 50.4 golfers on day one, rounding that to 51 total golfers. Any one school will be allowed to submit up to 6 qualifying golfers for entry.

For Day One Entry, each conference will determine own criteria for entry into District One Tournament:

The Northwest Conference will receive 66% of the 51 golfers for a total of 34 golfers in 2015 and 34 golfers in 2016. The Cascade Conference will receive 25.4% of the 51 golfers for a total of 13 golfers in 2015 and 13 golfers in 2016. Shorecrest will get 4 golfers in 2015 and 2016. If Shorecrests 5th and 6th place meets or exceeds the cut score average 51 qualifying golfers, they will have an entry into the district tournament. (Note: this is in place for Shorecrest as any one school can qualify up to 6 golfers.)

For Day Two Qualifying:

The field will be cut in half taking the top 50% of the field from day one plus any ties or reduced to the doubled the amount of allocations to state, whichever is greater. In year 2015, the cut will be from 51 to 32 (doubling the allocation 16 to state for the boys) plus ties. In year 2016, the cut will be from 51 to 34 (doubling the allocation 17 to state for the boys) plus ties.

2015 Boys 2A NW District Golf Tournament Rules

Schedule of 2A Boys District Golf Tournament:

Monday, May 18th tee times

12:30 pm /Snohomish Golf Course--7 & 8 minute intervals (all qualifiers off hole #1 and #10)

Tuesday, May 19th tee times

12:30 pm/Snohomish Golf Course--7 & 8 minute intervals (off hole #1)

Team Championship:

The team champion will be determined on Tuesday, May 19th. Determined by the combined scores of two or more players from the same school who play the entire 36 hole tournament. One player does not constitute a team. A trophy will be awarded to the first place team only. In the event of a tie golfers from the tied teams will play a "sudden death" playoff. The Tournament Director will appoint a Tournament Official to accompany the play-off contestants.

Individual Championships:

The individual championship will be determined over two (2) days. In the event of a tie for the 1st Place Medalist Honors, there will be a playoff. The playoff will be a sudden death and additional holes will be played until the tie is broken. The Tournament Director will appoint a tournament official to accompany the playoff contestants. The tournament Director will determine which holes are to be played in the event a playoff is necessary. If there is a tie for places 2 through 10, a chip off will determine the results. In no event will more than ten (10) individual medals be awarded unless there is a tie for the last position.

Allocations to State: (16 in 2015) (17 in 2016)

If there is a tie for the last allocation spot, there will be a sudden death playoff immediately following the tournament. The next two golfers in place following the number determined by WIAA allocations will be alternates to the State Tournament.

Coaches Meeting:

All Coaches (or representative) must attend the coaches meetings prior to the Tournament. Attendance by a coach or representative from each school with tournament participants is **mandatory**. The time and location are as follows:

Monday, May 18 & Tuesday, May 19th, 11:45 am, Snohomish Golf Course Club House.

Starting Times:

The Tournament Director will make up the parings. No two golfers representing the same school may play in the same paring. All Tuesday tee times will be in reverse order of their first round score. The five minute rule in assigned tee times will be strictly enforced. In each day of the tournament, all participants are required to check in at the registration table with their coach or faculty representative, no later than 15 minutes prior to their assigned tee time.

Soft Spikes are preferred to be used at the District Tournament.

Practice Rounds:

When scheduling practice rounds please let the golf course know you have juniors in your group to get the best price.

Coach/Faculty Representative:

The golf coach or a school faculty representative must accompany all participating golfers to the District Tournament. These coaches or representatives must stay at the course site until their team or school individuals have completed play. Coaches will not be allowed to play at the tournament site on the day of the tournament.

Food:

Snohomish Golf Course Café will be open during the tournament. Prices are reasonable.

No brown bagging in the upstairs dining area.

Rules Committee: Will consist of Fred Jacobson (Golf Pro), Dave White (WJGA) and Mike Hamm (WJGA).

Rules:

- ✓ USGA Rules will govern, except in cases of local ground rule changes. The 2A Boys District Tournament will be governed by the Rules Committee. The Tournament Director will appoint the Rules Committee. Any disputes or doubtful points on rules shall be referred to the Committee whose decision shall be final. USGA rules state, during a two-day tournament, those players who qualify for the second day may not play a practice round on the tournament course after completion of the qualifying round on day one.
- ✓ Contestants will keep each other's score within the pairing. The tournament official scorer will not accept score cards unless they are signed by both the individual player and his scorer. Attesting areas will be provided along with a tournament official to conduct the attesting immediately after the completion of the final hole on each day of the tournament. Penalty for an unsigned scorecard is automatic disqualification. Participants must report to the attesting area after completion of each round, promptly and without delay.
- ✓ As per USGA rules, slow play rules will be enforced. Participants must play "Ready Golf" and keep up with the pairing ahead.
- ✓ All Putts must be holed out according to USGA Rules. Failure to do so will disqualify the player.
- ✓ The 2A Boys District Tournament will be played from **6325** yards.
- ✓ The following violations may result in disqualification:
 - ♦ Smoking, use and or possession of tobacco substances
 - Use and/or possession of alcohol or any other controlled substance/drug.
 - ♦ Abusive language swearing
 - ♦ Use of Range Finders
 - ♦ Betting
 - ♦ No cell phones

(All players are responsible to report violations of these provisions to a Rules Marshal at the first opportunity.)

- ✓ <u>Club Throwing: There will be a two-stroke penalty for throwing a club.</u> Should a second offense occur, the individual will automatically be disqualified from further Tournament Play.
- ✓ No caddies or motorized carts will be permitted. Players with a physical disability, which may require a cart, must, at the Coaches meeting, provide a doctor's note requesting the cart. The tournament directors will review the situation and make a decision. It is permissible for a player to pull his own golf cart.

On the day of the Tournament, practice is restricted to the putting green and the practice range area only. On delays between nines, participants are allowed to utilize the practice putting greens. No use of the driving range between nines will be allowed. Range balls for practice prior to the start of the Tournament are available at the Pro Shop at school's expense. (\$2.00 per small bucket, \$3.75 for large bucket - Cash or Checks only - **No School P.O.'s**) Between Round 1 and Round 2 no participant may utilize the tournament course for practice.

- ✓ Galleries are permitted; however, all spectators are to keep at least 25 yards distance from the competitors and stay on the cart path. The etiquette of golf will be observed at all times. Players who have completed their round are allowed to be part of the gallery, but must follow the gallery restrictions. Golf carts will not be allowed for players or spectators. Exception: Spectators with medical necessity for a cart are to be referred to the course manager or his designee.
- ✓ All contestants and spectators must be clothed in proper golf attire, including: 1) shirts must have sleeves and collars and must be worn at all times. 2) Slacks or tailored shorts (mid-thigh or longer) only. 3) No jeans or jean material (denim) will be allowed and all clothing must be worn in a neat and respectable manner from the time the players arrive at the course until the time they leave. Violators of this dress code will be asked to leave the course and will be disqualified from the Tournament. No radios, cellular phones, range finders or head phones are allowed.
- ✓ The official starter will review and make any changes for the day.
- ✓ The Tournament will be played under Summer Rules unless changed by the Tournament Committee due to course conditions.
