8:00 AM — Coaches meeting in classroom immediately following weigh-ins

9:30 AM — Wrestling begins

All sessions will be run back to back on three (3) mats until championship matches are completed.

For finals: $1^{st}/2^{nd}$ on center mat; $3^{rd}/4^{th}$ and $5^{th}/6^{th}$ on two side mats.

WEIGH-IN

- a. National Federation Wrestling Rules weigh-in procedures will be used at all WIAA Regional Tournaments.
- b. Athletes must bring photo I.D. and weigh-in cards that will be provided to coaches upon arrival.
- c. Officials will be at the weigh-ins for skin checks. Officials will be at each scale.
- d. There will be a certified doctor at weigh-in available to check any wrestler.

LOCKER ROOMS

Locker rooms will be provided. Individuals will need to provide their own towels and are expected to treat the facilities with care. PLEASE do not leave valuables in the locker rooms.

WARM-UPS

The mats will be available for the wrestlers from 8:30am until 9:15am to warm up.

MISCELLANEOUS

- 1. A hospitality room, sponsored by the Shorecrest Wrestling parents, will be open to coaches and officials only.
- 2. Busses: there is ample room for busses to park near the gym. Please do not park in front of the school in the fire lane area.
- 3. Concessions will be available and provided by the Shorecrest High School Booster Club.

FLOOR RESTRICTIONS

This is a WIAA post-season event. Spectators will not be allowed in the wrestling areas.

- a) There will be designated areas for spectators and teams/coaches
- b) Only two representatives per school allowed on each mat.
- c) No one will be allowed to stand along the mats.
- d) Limit of four (4) cheerleaders will be allowed mat side.
- e) Photographers and video cameras <u>Will NOT be allowed on the mats</u>. Please inform parents that they will not be allowed to photograph in the wrestling area.

TOURNAMENT POINTS

All tournament scoring will be as stated in the national Federation Rule Book.

The top six (6) placers in each weight class earn points at the following ratio:

FIRST PLACE	16 points	FOURTH PLACE	7 points
SECOND PLACE	12 points	FIFTH PLACE	5 points
THIRD PLACE	9 points	SIXTH PLACE	3 points

AWARDS

Individual $1^{st} - 4^{th}$ place at each weight will receive a medal from the WIAA that will be presented during the championship session.

Team scores will be kept and the 1st Place team will receive a trophy provided by the Shoreline School District Athletic Dept.

QUALIFYING FOR STATE

Top FOUR in each weight class will qualify for the WIAA Mat Classic.

The 5th place finisher will become the alternate at the Mat Classic.

PROTESTS

Any dispute occurring at the tournament will be presented to the Tournament Director who will confer with the Tournament Committee. The committee decision will be final.

The WIAA expulsion rule (23.32 – Conduct eligibility rules and penalties) will be followed.

WIAA TOURNAMENT RULES

WIAA tournament rules will apply. (i.e. Sportsmanship, signs, noisemakers, floor restrictions, coaches in the corner and admissions.)
