FEE: Each school will be billed by West Central District a \$25.00 fee per entry.

PIG-TAIL MATCHES: These matches are between two leagues for a spot in the 12 entry draw. These should be

played before the tournament begins. Results should be sent immediately to the tournament

director.

FACILITIES: Locker rooms are available inside the tennis center.

TENNIS BALLS: Each school should bring two (2) cans of tennis balls per entry.

COURT ASSIGNMENTS: Courts for matches will be assigned by the meet manager.

DRESS: Each participant must be wearing an appropriate tennis shirt approved by the school. Cut-offs or jeans are illegal. All lettering or writing on the uniform is restricted to school identification. If a violation occurs, the Tournament Manager or designee is empowered to disqualify the player.

COACHING: Coaching is permitted at the end of a set for 2 minutes by one school coach.

TIEBREAKERS: Regular tiebreaker scoring will be used for the first and second sets. A super tiebreaker will be used for the 3rd set if weather necessitates.

ORDER OF PLAY: Weather permitting, matches 1-4 in both singles and doubles will begin after the players' meeting. If we have inclement weather, singles matches 1-4 will begin approximately 8:15 followed by doubles matches 1-4.

CONDUCT: The meet manager or designee is given the authority to warn or disqualify any player who displays unsportsmanlike conduct, including but not limited to temper and profanity. This would apply to hitting the ball or throwing rackets from the playing area in a fit of temper.

1st violation – loss of point

- 2nd violation loss of game
- 3rd violation loss of match

All players will receive a warning at the players meeting.

SPECTATORS: All spectators, players and coaches alike are restricted to the viewing area. **Parents may not coach players at any time during match play.** Unnecessary noise or distractions are not customary at a tennis match. The applauding of errors is considered poor etiquette. Applause is in order for excellent play and winning shots.

4th Place-----3 team points
