STATE QUALIFIERS

The first four place finishers in each weight division will qualify for the State Wrestling Tournament to be held in the Tacoma Dome February 20th and 21st.

The 5th place finisher will become the alternate at the State Tournament. The alternate will be used in the event of a scratch by a higher placer for their district only.

MATCHES ENDING IN A DRAW

For the Championship finals, two officials will be used.

PROTEST
