W.I.A.A. tournament rules will apply. (i.e. Sportsmanship, signs, noisemakers, floor restrictions, coaches in the corner and admissions.)

FLOOR RESTRICTIONS

There will be no reserved seating sections. Space will be limited when we are wrestling on two mats. A coach, assistant coach, trainer, or manager, not a wrestler, will be permitted to sit in the chairs mat side during the matches. The limit is two coaches per school at a mat. We insist they remain seated in their chair during the course of the match and not run onto the mat for coaching or any other purpose, unless there is an injury. No one other than official staff will be allowed on the floor. Photographers and Video Cameras will not be allowed on the floor.
