Post Season Agreement

updated 9/16/15

This agreement is made between the Olympic League 1A schools (Chimacum HS, Coupeville HS, Klahowya HS, Port Townsend HS) and the Nisqually League schools (Bellevue Christian, Cascade Christian, Charles Wright Academy, Seattle Christian, Vashon HS) for the 2014-2016 Allocation Cycle.

Fall Sports:

Cross Country - Each School within the District will send all of their teams to the Westside Classic at American Lakes Golf Course on Saturday, November 1, 2014 and Saturday, October 31, 2015.

Football – Week #10 (November 7/8) of the WIAA football season has been set aside for the Olympic League and the Nisqually League to play Crossover games to determine the seeds into the WIAA State Tournament.

- 2014 – The top two teams from the Olympic and Nisqually League will play for two berths into the WIAA 1A State Football Tournament.
 - Format – O2@N1 & N2@O1
 - If both #1's win; the Olympic League will receive the #1 seed in 2014.
 - If both #2's win; the Olympic League will receive the #1 seed in 2014.
 - If both teams from the same league win the cross-over game the league champion will receive the #1 seed.
 - Non Playoff Cross-over games; Nisqually 3 @ Olympic 3, Nisqually 4 @ Olympic 4
- 2015 – **Week #10 (November 6/7) The top three teams from the Olympic and Nisqually League will play for three berths into the WIAA 1A State Football Tournament**
 - **Format – N3@O1, O3@N1, O2@N2**
 - **If both #1's win; the Nisqually League will receive the #1 seed in 2015.**
 - **If both #3's win; The number #2 team that wins will receive the #1 seed.**
 - **If the number 3 team from one league wins and the number #2 team from the same league wins, the number two team from that league will be the higher seed.**
 - **Non Playoff Cross-over game: O4 @ N4.**

Girls Soccer – This tournament will be based on the agreed upon Modified double elimination tournament. In this tournament format the first round games (Game 1 & 2) will be single elimination.

- 2014 – The top three teams from the Olympic and Nisqually League will play for two berths into the WIAA 1A State tournament.
 - Format: Modified double elimination (refer to brackets)
 - Dates: Games 1 & 2 – Saturday, November 1; Games 3 & 4 – Tuesday, November 4; Games 5 & 6 – Thursday, November 6; Game 7 – Saturday, November 8.
 - Sites: Game 1-4 will be played at the higher seeds district approved site. Game 5-7 will be played at a Neutral site determined by the WCD.
- 2015 – **The top three teams from the Olympic and top four teams from the Nisqually League will play for three berths into the WIAA 1A State tournament.**
 - **Format: Same format as 2014 with the addition of a pigtail game with N4&O3 to determine who will play N2 in game #1.**
 - **Dates: Pigtail Game – Thursday, October 29; Games 1 & 2 – Saturday, October 31; Games 3 & 4 – Tuesday, November 3; Games 5 & 6 – Thursday, November 5;**

- **Sites: Pigtail game will be played at Olympic district approved site; Game 1-4 will be played at the higher seeds district approved site. Game 5-7 will be played at a Neutral site determined by the WCD.**

NOTE: In the event a neutral site cannot be secured games 5,6 & 7 will be played at a Olympic League site in 2014 and a Nisqually League site in 2015.

Volleyball – This tournament will be based on the agreed upon Modified double elimination tournament. In this tournament format the first round games (Game 1 & 2) will be single elimination.

- **2014** – The top three teams from the Olympic and Nisqually League will play for two berths into the WIAA 1A State tournament.
 - Format: Modified double elimination (refer to brackets)
 - Dates: Games 1 & 2 – Thursday, November 6; Games 3 - 7 – Saturday, November 8.
 - Sites: Game 1 & 2 will be played at the higher seed site. Game 3-7 will be played at a Neutral site determined by the WCD.
- **2015** – **The top three teams from the Olympic and top four teams from the Nisqually League will play for two berths into the WIAA 1A State tournament.**
 - **Format: Same format as 2014 with the addition of a pigtail game with N4&O3 to determine who will play N2 in game #1.**
 - **Dates: Pigtail Game – Tuesday, October 27; Games 1 & 2 – Thursday, October 29; Games 3 - 7 – Saturday, October 31;**
 - **Sites: Pigtail @ Olympic league site; Game 1&2 will be played at the higher seeds district approved site; Game 3-7 will be played at the site of the Nisqually League Champion.**

NOTE: In the event a neutral site cannot be secured games 5,6 & 7 will be played at a Olympic League site in 2014 and a Nisqually League site in 2015.

Boys Tennis – Tournament will be based on an **eight** entry double elimination tournament for both singles and doubles teams. The West Central District will need to include a single berth for Eatonville HS (District #4) into tournament.

- The Olympic League will send their top three singles and top three doubles teams.
- The Nisqually League will send their top three singles and top three doubles teams.
- The Olympic League and Nisqually League #4 singles and #4 doubles will pigtail into tournament.
- Eatonville will be granted one berth to tournament as a result of District 4 joining with District 3 for 1A tennis.
 - Eatonville’s entry will be seeded accordingly to strength of teams as not to unbalance brackets.
- Date: October 29th, 2015
- Site: Sprinker Tennis Center, Tacoma; Start Time = 9:00am
- \$25.00 per team entry will be charged the school in which participants come from.
- There will be two berths to the State tournament – Spring 2016

WINTER SPORTS:

Boys & Girls Basketball - This tournament will be based on the agreed upon Modified double elimination tournament. In this tournament format the first round games (Game 1 & 2) will be single elimination.

- 2015 – The top three teams from the Olympic and Nisqually League will play for two(?) berths into the WIAA 1A State tournament.
 - Format: Modified double elimination (refer to brackets)
 - Dates: Games 1 & 2 – Saturday, February 14 (B&G)
Games 3 & 4 – Tuesday, February 17 (Boys)
Wednesday, February 18 (Girls)
Games 5 & 6 – Thursday, February 19 (Boys)
Friday, February 20 (Girls)
Game 7 – Saturday, February 21 (B&G)
 - Sites: Game 1-4 will be played at the higher seeds district approved site. Game 5-7 will be played at a Neutral site determined by the WCD.
- 2016 – **The top three teams from the Olympic and top four teams from the Nisqually League will play for three berths into the WIAA 1A State tournament.**
 - **Format: Same format as 2014 with the addition of a pigtail game with N4&O3 to determine who will play N2 in game #1.**
 - **Dates: Pigtail – Thursday, February 11 (B&G)
Games 1 & 2 – Saturday, February 13 (B&G)
Games 3 & 4 – Tuesday, February 16 (Girls)
Wednesday, February 17 (Boys)
Games 5 & 6 – Thursday, February 18 (Girls)
Friday, February 19(Boys)
Game 7 – Saturday, February 20 (B&G)**
 - **Sites: Game 1-4 will be played at the higher seeds district approved site. Game 5-7 will be played at a Neutral site determined by the WCD.**
 - **If the same school has both boys and girls playing in tournament than they can host on the same night. IF it is mutually agreed upon by the schools involved.**

NOTE: In the event a neutral site cannot be secured games 5,6 & 7 will be played at a Olympic League site in 2014 and a Nisqually League site in 2015.

Boys Soccer – This tournament will be based on the agreed upon Modified double elimination tournament. In this tournament format the first round games (Game 1 & 2) will be single elimination.

- 2015 – The top three teams from the Olympic and Nisqually League will play for three berths into

the WIAA 1A State tournament.

- Format: Modified double elimination (refer to brackets)
- Dates: Games 1 & 2 – Saturday, May 09; Games 3 & 4 – Tuesday, May 12; Games 5 & 6 – Thursday, May 14; Game 7 – Saturday, May 16.
- Sites: Game 1-4 will be played at the higher seeds district approved site. Game 5-7 will be played at a Neutral site determined by the WCD.
- **2016 – The top three teams from the Olympic and top four teams from the Nisqually League will play for two berths into the WIAA 1A State tournament.**
 - **Format: Two berth format with the addition of a pigtail game with N4&O3 to determine who will play N2 in game #1.**

 - Format: Modified double elimination (refer to brackets)
 - Dates: Games 1 & 2 – Saturday, May 09; Games 3 & 4 – Tuesday, May 12; Games 5 & 6 – Thursday, May 14; Game 7 – Saturday, May 16.
 - Sites: Game 1-4 will be played at the higher seeds district approved site. Game 5-7 will be played at a Neutral site determined by the WCD.
- **2016 – The top three teams from the Olympic and top four teams from the Nisqually League will play for two berths into the WIAA 1A State tournament.**
 - **Format: Same format as 2014 with the addition of a pigtail game with N4&O3 to determine who will play N2 in game #1.**

 - Format: Modified double elimination (refer to brackets)
 - Dates: Games 1 & 2 – Thursday, May 21; Games 3 - 7 – Saturday, May 23.
 - Sites: Game 1 & 2 will be played at the higher seed site. Game 3-7 will be played at a Neutral site determined by the WCD.
- **2016 – The top three teams from the Olympic and top four teams from the Nisqually League will play for two berths into the WIAA 1A State tournament.**
 - **Format: Same format as 2014 with the addition of a pigtail game with N4&O3 to determine who will play N2 in game #1.**

- **Dates: Pigtail Game – Tuesday, May 17; Games 1 & 2 – Thursday, May 19; Games 3 - 7 – Saturday, May 21;**
- **Sites: Pigtail @ Olympic league site; Game 1&2 will be played at the higher seeds district approved site; Game 3-7 will be played at a Neutral site determined by the WCD.**

Girls Tennis – Tournament will be based on an **eight** entry double elimination tournament for both singles and doubles teams.

- The Nisqually League will send their top four singles and top four doubles teams.
- The Olympic League will send their top four singles and top four doubles teams.
- Date: Week of May 18-23, 2015 & Week of May 16 – 21, 2016
- Site: TBD (Indoor site will be secured)
- \$25.00 per team will be charged to the school in which participants come from.

Track & Field – Will consist of a two day meet; Pre-lims & finals.

Individual Events

- Nisqually (5 teams) = 7 automatic entries (Top seven in league)
- Olympic (4 teams) = 6 automatic entries (Top six in league)
- Next three fastest times according to Athletic.net
 - Times will be based on F.A.T. timing. NO hand timing will be accepted.

Relays

- Nisqually (5 teams) = 4 automatic entries (Top four in league)
- Olympic (4 teams) = 3 automatic entries (Top three in league)
- The fastest time between the N5 or O4 will round out field.
 - Times will be based on F.A.T. timing. No hand timing will be accepted.

Boys Golf – An 18 hole tournament will be played on Tuesday, May 19 2015 (Tuesday, May 18 2016)

- 27 golfers will compete for the allotted allocation amount to the WIAA State Tournament.
 - Nisqually (5 teams) will qualify 15 golfers
 - Olympic (4 teams) will qualify 12 golfers

Girls Golf - An 18 hole tournament will be played on Tuesday, May 19 2015 (Tuesday, May 18 2016)

- 27 golfers will compete for the allotted allocation amount to the WIAA State Tournament.
 - Nisqually (5 teams) will qualify 15 golfers
 - Olympic (4 teams) will qualify 12 golfers

Note: In both Boys and Girls golf, the tournament will be shrunk by three golfers for each team that does not field a complete team (5 golfers).
