

MHS Winter Sports 2019-2020!

The winter sports season is right around the corner, beginning <u>Monday</u>, <u>November 18th</u> (Gymnastics – Monday, November 11th). If you are interested in any of the following sports, be sure to get registered, using our on-line registration via your parent Family Access account:

- Boys or Girls Basketball
- Boys Swim & Dive

- Boys or Girls Wrestling
- Girls Gymnastics

To register, sign-in to your **parent** Family Access account, then click on the "Online Forms" tab, then the "Athletic Registration" tab. Once the on-line forms are completed, press "submit".

<u>Please remember to print and return</u> the following forms to the Athletic Office if you did not upload them during your on-line registration:

- Medical History Questionnaire (must update every school year) and
- *Physical Exam Form* (good for 24 months from date of physical exam)

<u>No Family Access account?</u> Apply on-line by going to **http://www.monroe.wednet.edu** then click on "Family Access", then "Set up a Family Access Account." You should receive your Family Access account log-in information via email within 24-48 hours. (Parents of home school students who are not registered through Monroe School District may contact Heather Jackson at 360-804-2572 for assistance with setting up a Family Access account).

If you registered for a fall sport and selected a winter sport during that session, you do not need to register again. If you did not select a winter sport during your fall registration, you may add it by amending your on-line registration page, or by calling/stopping by the Athletic Office.

To allow time for processing, please have your on-line registration submitted by <u>Friday</u>, <u>November 8th</u> (Gymnastics: Monday, November 4th)

Additional information:

The following information **MUST** be on file in the athletic office before the first practice. Failure to have the following will result in student not being able to participate:0

- On-line Registration completed
- *Medical History Questionnaire* printed, completed, and uploaded or turned-in to the Athletic Office (*must update each school year*)

- *Current Physical* completed and uploaded or turned-in to the Athletic Office (*good for 24 months from date of exam and must cover the entire sport season*). If obtaining a new physical please use our form available on registration site, district website or in the office
- *Insurance information* Company Name and Group/Policy numbers
- Current year ASB card paid -\$50 collected when athlete gets cleared, if not already paid
- All outstanding *fines paid*
- Pay-to-Play fee paid (once on the team) \$110 due no later than Friday, November 29th
- If you qualify for free or reduced lunch, you are eligible for a waiver of the Pay-to-Play fee. A signed waiver form or a copy of your verification letter must be received by the Athletic Office *no later than Friday, Friday, November 29th*
- The Pay-to-Play fee is non-refundable except for the following conditions:
 - o Student unable to play due to illness or injury prior to first competition
 - o Student unable to play due to family moving prior to first competition
- If home school or SVEC please bring proof of previous semester grades and vaccination records
- If transfer from another district please bring previous semester report card or transcript and vaccination records
- Running Start, Homeschool, Sno-Isle, and Leaders in Learning students require a WIAA Eligibility form (available on the registration site or in the office)
