

# MHS Spring 2018–2019 Sports!

MHS Spring 2018-19 sports season begins **Monday, February 25th**. If you are interested in any of the following sports, be sure to get registered, using our on-line registration via your **parent** Family Access account.

- Baseball
- Boys Soccer
- Boys and Girls Golf
- Fastpitch Softball
- Girls Tennis
- Boys and Girls Track

To register, sign-in to your parent Family Access account, then click on the “Online Forms” tab, then the “Athletic Registration” tab. Once the on-line forms are completed, press “submit”.

\*\*\* **Please remember to print and return** the following forms to the Athletic Office if you did not upload them during your on-line registration: **Medical History Questionnaire** and **Physical Exam Form**.

*If you have already registered for a sport this school year*, you do not need to register again. Please let the Athletic Office know of your intent to play if you have not already checked a spring sport during your registration session.

No Family Access account? Apply on-line by going to <http://www.monroe.wednet.edu> then click on “Family Access”, then “Set up a Family Access Account.” You should receive your Family Access account log-in information via email within 24-48 hours. (Parents of home school students who are not registered through Monroe School District may contact Heather Jackson at 360-804-2572 for assistance with setting up a Family Access account).

You **must** complete the on-line registration forms each school year regardless of whether you participated in late spring or summer programs (ie: spring football, summer camps, etc.).

*To allow time for processing, please have your on-line registration submitted by **Wednesday, February 13<sup>th</sup>***

The Athletic Office is open 7:00 am – 3:30 pm Monday – Friday to collect any paperwork (Medical History forms and Physical Exam forms) and payments not submitted on-line.

## **Additional information:**

The following information **MUST** be on file in the athletic office before the first practice. Failure to have the following will result in student not being able to practice.

- ***On-line Registration*** completed
- ***Medical History Questionnaire*** printed, completed, signed, and either uploaded or turned-in to the Athletic Office
- ***Current Physical*** completed and uploaded or turned-in to the Athletic Office – good for 2 years and must cover the entire sport season – if obtaining a new physical please use our form – available on registration site, website or in the office
- ***Insurance information*** – Company Name and Group/Policy numbers. School insurance available for purchase if needed
- Current year ***ASB*** card paid – ***\$50 – collected when athlete gets cleared***, if not already paid
- All outstanding ***fines paid***
- ***Pay-to-Play*** fee paid (once on the team) – ***\$110 – due by Friday, March 8<sup>th</sup>***.
- If you qualify for free or reduced lunch, you are eligible for a waiver of the Pay-to-Play fee. A signed waiver form or a copy of your verification letter must be received by the Athletic Office ***by Friday, March 8<sup>th</sup>***.
- The Pay-to-Play fee is non-refundable except for the following conditions.
  - Student unable to play due to illness or injury prior to first competition.
  - Student unable to play due to family moving prior to first competition.
- If Homeschool or SVEC – please bring proof of previous semester grades and vaccination records
- If transfer from another district – please bring previous semester report card or transcript and vaccination records
