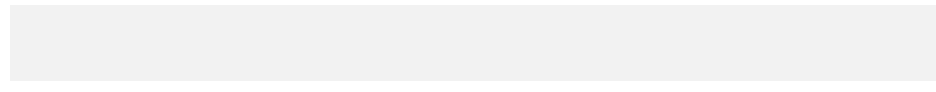
Unified Basketball registration is open - they gearing up to get started after break.

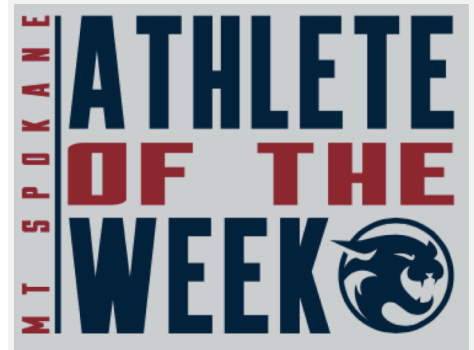
