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- All players will have all paperwork, including a current physical on file at Central Kitsap High School in accordance to the policies set forth by Central Kitsap School District. Players will not be allowed to try-out or participate without the proper paperwork.
- All players will follow the Central Kitsap Athletic code.

AS A MEMBER OF THE CKHS GIRL'S SOCCER TEAM I WILL

- 1) Do my best academically, maintain a positive attitude, and allow myself to be coached.
- 2) Understand and sign a playing time contract.
- 3) Give 100% during every practice and game.
- 4) Take care of my personal needs before practice so that I am able to make the best use of the time I have to prepare for games.
- 5) Be at practice, ready to begin, promptly at 3:15. I am to be on time. If I am habitually late, I could face game suspension or possible removal from the team.
- 6) Wear shin guards at all time during practices and games. I understand that jewelry is not to be worn at practices or games. Medical bracelets are permitted.
- 7) Attend all practices and games. If I know I am going to be late or gone from practice or a game, <u>I must contact a coach beforehand</u>. If I do not contact a coach, I am considered unexcused. Consequences are listed below.
 - 1st offense One game suspension
 - 2nd offense Two game suspension
 - 3rd offense Removal from the team
- **8**) Be aware that profanity on the practice or game field will not be tolerated. I understand that continual abuse could lead to suspension or possible removal from the team.
- 9) Not talk back or argue with referees. My job is to play soccer. I will let my coaches take care of the referees.

- **10**) Notify my coach if I suffer an injury at practice or a game. The coach will then determine if the trainer is needed. I will not leave practice or a game with an unreported injury.
- 11) Not use electronic devices at practice or during games. Devices should be powered off during those times. I understand that appropriate use of these devices is permitted on our team bus.
- **12**) Treat each member of the team with respect. This includes teammates, coaches, managers, trainers, scorekeepers or anyone else who helps our team. I will also treat my opponents with respect.
- **13**) Be aware that if I am given a red card, I am automatically not eligible for All League consideration.
- **14**) Be aware that if I am not in school the entire day, meaning attending ALL classes I am enrolled in, (except for a medical or dental appointment) I am not eligible to practice or participate in a game. If I have a medical or dental appointment before school, during the school day, or after school, I need to bring a signed note from the doctor or dentist and I will be allowed to participate.
- **15**) Be aware that if I go to a doctor of any kind at any time, I must bring a note clearing me to participate.
- **16)** Ride the bus to every away match (except games at Silverdale Stadium). Mr. Baxter, CKHS Athletic Director, may approve an exception to this rule for personal reasons. However, this request must be made a minimum of 24 hours in advance or one school day in advance whichever is greater.
- 17) Ride the bus home from every away match. I understand that my parent/guardian must sign me out if they wish to take me home. I may not ride home with another parent unless I bring a note of permission from my parent/guardian. The parent must have filled out and signed the school district transportation and insurance form.
- **18**) Contact my coaches or Athletic Director if I have any questions regarding the rules and procedures of CKHS Girls' Soccer.
