

Cougar Golf

1. Team practice at KGCC golf course shall only be done when a golf coach or a designee is also at the facility. Players need to be at all practices unless a prior arrangement with the coach is made. Players must be at school for all classes (except for Dr. Appointment or other emergency) to practice or participate in a match.
2. Attendance at all practices is mandatory with any absences communicated in advance to the head coach. Failure to communicate said absences (not including absences excused after the fact due to emergency circumstances) will result in that player not being eligible to compete in the next scheduled match. 3 unexcused absences will result in removal from the team.
3. Because of accelerated member play at KGCC beginning in March, practice is Monday or Thursday only. Tuesday and Wednesday are at the driving range on Waaga Way beginning at 3:15 (unless otherwise instructed). Friday practices TBD.
4. All players are to be at putting green no later than 2:30 for home matches. For those not playing in an away match, practice is suspended unless otherwise notified.
5. Speed limit in the parking lot is 10 mph. Use caution and care at all times.
6. Proper attire will be required at all times. This means:
Boys: No cutoffs, short shorts, tank tops, jeans, Tee Shirts, sweat pants, or unkempt clothing. Boys must wear shirts with collars, Bermuda or walking shorts (mid thigh length).
Girls: No cutoffs, short shorts, tank tops, jeans, Tee Shirts, sweat pants, or bare midriffs. Shirts must have collar or sleeves.
7. No loitering around the pro shop or clubhouse. Cocktail lounge is off limits.
8. Remember that KGCC is a private club and you should show the utmost courtesy to all members.
9. District rules for off campus events apply when you are representing your school at KG&CC, the driving range, and other sites for practice and/or matches.
10. Team participation will require that you partake in at LEAST ONE work party organized by the Greens Committee of KGCC.
11. Repair all divots and ball marks, plus any others you find on the course.
12. Players must meet WIAA guidelines. Depending on conditions, final cuts must be made by the end of the 1st week of practice.
13. Players should understand the rules of the sport and be able to play with some degree of skill. High school competitors should complete each 9 holes in about 2 hours.
14. If you have any questions, check with the coach or pro shop personnel.
