V. RAINOUT PROCEDURES

A. **Tuesday, April 30th @ Home Field of Higher Seeds**

Games #1 – 4 need to be completed by Friday Night, May 3, 2019. If any of these games are not played by Friday Night, May 3, 2019 the **higher seed** will automatically advance to Saturday May 4 Games.

In case of rainout, teams will be notified as soon as possible, usually by at least two hours prior to game time. The schedule below will be followed as closely as possible, but some adjustments may be necessary due to field/umpire availability.

Any game that is interrupted with teams having played less than the required number of innings will be continued from the point of suspension. The Tournament Director shall determine when the game will be completed. The line-up and batting order of each team shall be exactly the same as the line-up and batting order at the moment of suspension, subject to the rules governing the game. (Consistent with WIAA State Tournament Guidelines).

Efforts will be made not to play three days in a row, but that cannot be guaranteed. If games are cancelled and rescheduling is not covered in this bulletin, the situation will be resolved by the tournament committee.

Any games rained out on Volunteer Field will be played with a schedule determined at that time on Daniels Field.

B. If Saturday, May 4th is rained out on Volunteer Park schedule will be as follows:

All Games will be played on **Daniels Field** on Saturday, May 4.

C. If all games #5 - #8 are not completed by **Thursday, May 9th** then the tournament will be modified to a 4 team tournament with the original #1-4 seeds participating, and it will begin on **Friday May 10th** Game times to be announced.

D. If all games 1-4 are not completed by **Monday, May 13th**, then the #1 and #2 seeds will play for District Championship (both to state) and #3 and #4 seeds will play for regional seeding on **Tuesday, May 14th**; both teams to state. Game times will be established at a later date.

E. After **Wednesday, May 15th**, if no games have been played, the #1 entry into the state tournament will be the District 1 & 2 RPI rated teams #1, #2, #3, #4.

VI. OFFICIALS / UMPIRES

A. The reservation & payment of tournament umpires shall be the responsibility of the NW District One Director.

VII. TICKET INFORMATION

- A. Tickets will be sold at the gate. Gates will be open one hour prior to the first scheduled game.

VIII. PASSES/ROSTERS/PROGRAM INFORMATION

- A. Acceptable Passes: **WSCA passes, WSSAAA passes, NW District Event Supervisor's Pass (Blue back pass only), as well as the WIAA and NW District Lifetime pass will be honored.**

- B. Roster/dugout limit; **each school will be allowed a MAXIMUM OF 29 people on the pass list for admittance into the stadium**

Schedule, scores, roster and photo must be entered on the school's MaxPreps account.

All team/school personnel for the pass gate must be entered into the school's MyWIAA account.

20 players

5 designated school personnel (coaches, managers, statisticians, etc)

1 bat boy/girl (recommended seventh grade or older)

1 medical (must be a licensed health care provider)

2 supervisors

Please submit roster/pass list via email to Carey South @ csouth@asd103.org by April 29th @ 3:00 pm. Failure of non-submittal will result in your school being excluded from the program. Any last minute changes can be phoned in, or emailed no later than 3 PM, Friday, May 4th to the Anacortes Athletic Office 360-503-1308. **No changes will be permitted after first game.**

- C. Team eligibility will be in accordance with the WIAA State guidelines.
- D. Once the district tournament begins, team rosters may not be changed until the district tournament is completed (WIAA rule 22.3.0). In the event of an emergency or catastrophe after the tournament begins, team members may be replaced if approved by the tournament manager, thereby permitting a school to add eligible players to restore the team to the original number for tournament play (WIAA rule 22.3.1). The emergency or catastrophe must have an impact on a significant number of eligible team members, not just one or two individual players.

IX. TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

- A. The tournament director will collect starting lineups 45 minutes before game time. Teams will exchange line-ups at this time.
- B. Dressing facilities will NOT be available. **Teams are to come dressed and ready to play.**
- C. Batting Cages will NOT be available.
- C. Towels will NOT be provided.
- D. The home team will be the team with the higher seed.
- E. The home team will use the third base dugout.
- F. Each team will be allowed 10 minutes of infield/outfield warm up, starting with the home team.
- G. **Only uniformed players will be allowed on the team bench or in dugouts.**
- H. Athletic Trainer will be available on site to evaluate and provide ice for injuries. If player needs taped school/player needs to provide the tape.
- I. Game length / 10 run rule: All games are seven (7) innings and must be played to completion, except if one team is ahead by ten (10) runs or more after the completion of five (5) innings, in this case the game will be over. Any game ending in a tie after seven (7) innings, will continue until a winner is determined. In case of a game being called after it has begun due to inclement weather, five (5) innings will constitute a complete game. If the game is suspended due to inclement weather, the game will resume from the point of suspension per WIAA State Tournament Guidelines.
- J. Game balls will be provided. Teams must furnish their own warm-up balls.
- K. Tournament committee will provide the official scorekeeper and pitch counter.
- L. The 2018-19 WIAA Baseball State Guidelines will be followed.
- M. Supervision – Each participating school is to provide (1) administrator/designee for supervision. Please have this person identify themselves to the tournament director/supervisor.
- N. WIAA tournament rules regarding sportsmanship, signs/banners, noisemakers, etc. will be enforced.
- O. Dogs are NOT allowed at any of these facilities.
- P. Sunflower Seeds and gum are NOT allowed on Daniels Field.

X. AWARDS

A first place District 1 trophy will be awarded at the conclusion of the tournament.

XI. PROTESTS

Decisions on protests must be determined at the time of the protest. The tournament committee will act on all tournament protests.

XIII. PARKING, ENTRANCE AND TICKET SALES

- A. Ticket Sales: Ticket sales will be available at the entrances of both Daniels Fields & Volunteer Park & the restroom/concession stands building located between each fields.
- B. Transportation – AD’s please pass along the following information to your transportation department
 - a. Directions: From either North or South on I-5
Take exit #230 & head West on HWY 20 into Anacortes
Turn Right on Commercial Ave
Continue North on Commercial until 12th Street
Turn Left on 12th & continue to D Ave.
Turn Left on D Ave & then Left on 13th.
Travel one block to drop off team
 - b. Parking -Busses **MUST** park at Anacortes High School. There is not enough parking at the baseball fields to accommodate both busses and spectators.
