All games being played at Franklin Pierce HS and at the Fairgrounds / Bremerton.

1. <u>Dug Out Assignments</u>

The first team listed (top of the bracket) will occupy the first base dug out, the last team listed on the third base side.

2. Batting Practice

No cages available. No live hitting on field. No hitting into fences. Hitting whiffle balls is allowed, however, batters must be on warning track / dirt to protect the turf.

3. Rosters / Dugout Limit

Roster limit is the same as that used for the state tournament.

For baseball, the following limits apply:

20 Players

5 Designated school personnel (coaches, managers, stats, etc.)

1 Bat boy / girl (recommended 7th grade or older)

1 Medical (must be a licensed health care provider)

2 Supervisors

Rosters will be pulled from WPN (league) websites under the roster tab. Make sure to add supervisors, etc., and save a district PDF on the website. You do not need to send copy to me as I will pull from your website prior to the tournament.

- 4. League passes will not be accepted for admission.
- 5. Home Team

The team listed on the bottom of the bracket will be the home team.

6. Infield / Outfield Practice

Ten (10) minutes allowed for each team.

Introductions (10 minutes prior to game time)

Players, coaches and team managers will line up on baselines. Visitors introduced first. Please have team ready. Pledge of Allegiance will immediately follow introductions for the 1st game of the day.

7. Rain Out Schedule

If weather forces us to reschedule, I will work with the teams involved to reschedule the games. **Warning!** Sunday will be an option if we have rain on Saturday.

Since Olympic High School now has a synthetic field at the Fairgrounds site, teams should be aware that games could be moved to this site. It is imperative that teams are prepared to play on synthetic field which means that <u>metal cleats will NOT be allowed.</u> Molded cleats are acceptable. Game #18 (semi-final losers playing for 3rd/4th place) will play play on this field, so be prepared!

8. <u>Suspended Game</u>

Once a game has begun, and before five complete innings are completed, if the weather or darkness causes the umpires to stop play, the game will be <u>resumed at the point of suspension</u>.

14. Directions to Fairgrounds Complex (Address: 1200 NW Fairgrounds Rd, Bremerton 98311)

From Tacoma Narrows Bridge: Take Highway 16 over the Narrows Bridge through Bremerton, but don't exit until you reach the first Silverdale exit. Turn right at the stop sign and follow to Bucklin Hill Road (the second stoplight in Silverdale). Turn right on Bucklin Hill Road and travel approximately 1.5 miles. Turn right on Nels Nelson Road. At the stop sign, turn right on Fairgrounds Road and the field will be on the left.

From Seattle / Bremerton Ferry Terminal: When you get off of the ferry, follow Washington Avenue to Warren Avenue. Turn right onto Warren Avenue and travel approximately 4 miles. Turn left onto Fairgrounds Road. Go through two intersections. You will see the field on the left immediately after you go through the Stampede Boulevard intersection.

- 15. We are visitors at the Fairgrounds Complex, please respect the facility and do everything you and your school can do to be great guests. This includes: providing adequate supervision for your fans; picking up trash in dugouts and stands; ensuring cooperation with game officials and umpires; and ensuring that players respect the property and equipment.
- 16. Protests (NFHS Rule 10.2.i.1)

If there is a question about a rule that was possibly misapplied, the team's coach or captain shall inform the umpire at time of the play and before a pitch to the next batter of either team, or before the umpires leave the field if the play in question was the last play of the game.

- Protest committee will consult with umpires and coaches and make decision as to the best way to proceed with the contest.
- Tournament director will determine members of the protest committee.
- 17. The use of unmanned aerial vehicles ("UAV"), also know as drones, is prohibited for any purpose by any persons at WCD tournament venues. Tournament management shall refuse admission or entry for anyone attempting to use a UAV; and if necessary, tournament management shall remove anyone attempting to use a UAV and/or confiscate the UAV until the event has been completed. For purposes of this policy, a UAV is any aircraft without a human pilot aboard the device.
- 18. Please assign players to assist with foul balls on your side of the field. Thanks for the help!
