Supervision

Athletic Directors: Please email to the event manager on or before Wednesday, May 8th at 2:00 p.m., the name/cell phone number of the lead supervisor. The lead supervisor should check in with the Event Manager at least 30 minutes before contest start time.

Game Ball

Home team supplies three game balls.

Bus Drop Off

Use the Main St (Exit 3: I-5 south) and then turn left (east) on to E. 40th St. Go down to the last entrance on the left.

Locker Rooms

Locker rooms are located under the stadium for both teams. Home team will use the south side; visitors will use the north side.

Field Access

Coaches, players, managers, and athletic trainers are allowed field access.

Benches

Both team benches are located on the west side (stadium side of the field). Home bench is closest to the scoreboard.

Pre-Game Schedule

A minimum of 20 minutes will be allowed for warm up. Teams are to line up in front of their respective benches when two minute remains on the clock.

Player Introduction

- When two minutes remains on the pregame clock, teams are to line up in front of their respective benches.
- **Visiting Team:** As names are announced, each player should proceed to the center of the field and form a single line to the north facing the main grandstand. Visiting team should remain in line while the Home Team is introduced.
- **Home Team:** As names are announced, each player should proceed to the center of the field and form a single line to the south (scoreboard side) facing the main grandstand.

Medical Service. A certified athletic trainer will be available throughout the event.

 - **SONG & CHEERLEADER PASSES** Cheerleaders and song leaders of participating schools will be admitted free, only if **IN UNIFORM**.
