- 1. Ingersoll Stadium is located next to Olympia High School. The main parking lot is located east of the high school on North Street. Spectators should use this parking lot.
- 2. Team buses should drop off players in the North Street lot and will be directed to the bus parking lot off Carolyn Street where they will remain. Players will meet their bus at that location after the game.
- 3. The stadium locker rooms will open for game #1 participants one (1) hour prior to the start of the first game. Participants in game #2 will have access to the locker room after half time of game #1.
- 4. The visiting team listed as top line of bracket, will wear white jerseys. Home team listed second or bottom of the bracket will wear dark. The visiting team will use the locker room on the south end of the stadium with the home team using the north end locker room.
- 5. The turf field will be available for warm-up 30 minutes prior to the start of each game. Prior to that time the grass field behind the stadium will be available. Teams participating in game #2 will have 30 minutes of warm up on the turf field regardless of the ending time of game #1.
- 6. The visitor section of the grandstand is located on the south end with the home team located on the north end.
- 7. Onsite ticket sales will begin 45 minutes prior to the start of the first game. The ticket booth is located at the south end of the stadium by the North Street parking lot.

Ticket Prices set by WCD are \$9 Adults / \$7 Students and Seniors. Cash Only.

- 8. Open drink containers may not be brought into the stadium.
- 9. All bags and backpacks are subject to search prior to entering the stadium.
- 10. We do not allow seeds, gum, sugar-based/sports drinks on the track or turf areas.
