Roster and WCD Pass list

Rosters will be pulled from WPN websites under the roster tab. Make sure you add your supervisors. As per the Bound for State guidelines you will be allowed a roster of 22 and 6 team personnel including coaches, managers and statisticians.

Administrator Supervision

Each school will have an administrator or designee on site to supervise and assist with crowd control. Once on site, supervisors should check in with the site playoff manager.

Passes

League and season passes will not be honored. WSSAAA (Athletic Directors), WSCA (Coaches Association) and WCD Executive Board Executive Board passes are the only type that will be accepted.

Pregame schedule and Team Introductions

Pre-game warm up will be a minimum of 20 minutes. Teams playing in the first game on Tuesday, Thursday or Saturday will be allowed on the field 30 minutes prior to game time. During the warm up

period referees will inspect equipment and meet with team captains. With one minute remaining in the warm up period teams should line up in front of their respective benches.

The starting lineup for the visiting team will be introduced first. Each player should proceed to mid field and form a single line facing the main grandstand. They should remain in line while the home team is being introduced. When introduced, the home team will line up to the east of mid field. For the first game only, after the introductions, both teams should remain in line and turn to face the flag at the end of the stadium for reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance. Upon completion teams should return to their respective benches.

Game Ball

Three game balls should be furnished by the Home Team.

Uniforms

The home team will wear dark-colored jerseys. The visiting team will wear light-colored jerseys.
The home team is the team on the bottom of the WCD bracket.

Shoes

Most players prefer to wear the same cleats they would use on a natural grass field.

Training Room

Ice will be available and a trainer will be on site. Please bring your own taping supplies. There will be no tape supplied.

Locker Rooms

The locker room will be available. Please do not leave valuables in the locker room. Locker rooms will not be available on Tuesday or Thursday until halftime. Locker rooms will available 45 minutes before the first game on both Saturdays of the tournament.

Team Benches

Both team benches will be located on the east side of the field. The home team bench will be located left of midfield and the visiting team bench will be located to the right. Home team will be the team on the bottom of the bracket.

Only participants (coaches, players, managers, trainers) will be allowed on the field. Each school will be allowed two field passes for student reporters or photographers.

Spectators

Spectators will sit in the grandstands opposite the team benches.

Filming

There are a limited number of electrical outlets available around the stadium. Please bring plenty of battery power. No extension cords will be run across walkways.

Buses and Team Vans

Drop off participants in the back of the school and park in the lot closest to 112th street.

General Statements

All WCD/WIAA regulations for spectators will be enforced.

Bands will not be permitted at the tournament

The official school banner will be the only sign permitted

Any artificial noisemakers are prohibited and may be confiscated by tournament supervisors

The throwing of confetti or other materials is not allowed.

Protests

WIAA District Soccer Games Committee: Each Event Manager shall appoint and name a Games Committee for all postseason contests. Duties of the Games Committee shall be as follows:

1. Assist the tournament director as needed and be immediately available to him/her at all times during the event.
2. Act as an arbitration board of dispute on questions or protests that might arise. The final decision will be the consensus of the Games Committee.
3. Questions concerning infractions may be brought to the Games Committee by a coach or person in charge of a team, not by a contestant.
4. The Games Committee shall be composed of no fewer than three, nor more than five, members.
5. The Games Committee members may not be involved with the game under dispute and should be composed of 1) event manager, 2) coach, athletic director or school administrator, and 3) head official.
