GATES OPEN

The main ticket gates will be open starting at 6:00 PM.

STADIUM RE-ENTRY

Students leaving the stadium will not be allowed to re-enter. Adults will be stamped for in/out.

DIRECTIONS TO ROGERS HIGH SCHOOL

12801 – 86th Ave. East, Puyallup, WA 98373

Located at the corner of 86th Avenue East and 128th Street East, there are entrances to free parking lots on 86th Avenue and 128th Street. Team busses should enter off 86th for access to dedicated bus loading/unloading zones.

SPECTATOR PARKING

There are spectator parking lots on 86th Avenue and 128th Street.

SIDELINES & TEAM BENCH

Both team benches will be placed on the SAME sideline (north side of the field). Only participants (coaches, players, managers, and trainers) will be allowed on the field. Benches are separated by 10 yards. A fourth registered soccer official is placed at a table between the benches to assist in substitution and bench control. ***All fans are restricted to the south grandstand.***

The home team will warm up on the west end of the field (closer to the scoreboard) and occupy the WEST TEAM BENCH. The visiting team will warm up on the east end of the field (away from the scoreboard) and occupy the EAST TEAM BENCH.

NO SEEDS, GUM OR FOOD OF ANY KIND ALLOWED ON THE TURF. SCHOOLS VIOLATING THIS RULE WILL BE BILLED FOR CLEANUP COSTS.

SQUAD / SIDELINE SIZE - STRICTLY ENFORCED

22 Players

6 Designated school personnel

4 Supervisors (Names on the pass list)

The number of people on the sidelines is limited to: team members in uniform, coaches, and managers, ball boy/girl, team physician or trainer. The only coaches permitted to be on the sidelines during a playoff contest shall be limited to the coaches who have been named as soccer coaches by the school district for the regular season. All other persons without sideline authorization from game manager will be escorted to grandstand.

LOCKER ROOMS

The HOME team will use the boys locker room (in the gym building).

The VISITING team will use the girls locker room (in the gym building).

GAME JERSEYS

HOME SCHOOL will wear DARK COLORED JERSEYS

VISITING SCHOOL will wear WHITE COLORED JERSEYS

BALLS

The HOME TEAM is responsible for providing at least three game balls. Home team ball selection is subject to referee approval.

PRE-GAME SCHEDULE

The field will be available 60 minutes before the contest. The following time schedule will be kept, using the stadium scoreboard clock:

- Five minutes remaining – teams line up at their respective team benches then conduct an INTERNATIONAL WALKOUT to the far side hash marks with introduction of officials.
- Four minutes remaining – Team introductions, as follows:
 - + Visiting team – reserves, starters, and coaches (name and number only)
 - + Home team - reserves, starters, and coaches (name and number only)
- Two minutes remaining – Teams turn to face the American flag on the West end of the field. The National Anthem will be sung or played before the match.
- One minute remaining – teams face each other and advance to midfield to shake hands before returning to their bench.

Note: The stadium scoreboard clock will be set to allow for introductions prior to kick-off

HALF TIME INTERMISSION

The half time intermission shall be 10 minutes. The timer will start the clock once the home team crosses the field and most of the players are off the track towards the home locker room. There will be **NO HALF TIME** field shows, i.e., Band, Drill, or Cheer.

SEATING

The tournament manager will assign each participating school a rooting section. The supervision of this section will be the responsibility of the school. Spectators are not allowed on the playing field at any time, and are required to stay behind the fenced areas at all times.

WIAA tournament regulations state that a section of seating **must be available** for students who wish to stand for prolonged periods. (WIAA State Tournament Packet. PG. 6, Item M)

WARNING: Viewing the game from the Student Section may be obstructed due to prolonged standing.

Home Team Schools ([bottom on bracket](#)) will sit in the **WEST** half of the South grandstands. **Student seating** will be in the section immediately **WEST** (and adjacent) to the center section of the South grandstand.

Visiting Team Schools ([top on bracket](#)) will sit in **EAST** half of the South grandstands. **Student seating** will be in the section immediately **EAST** (and adjacent) to the center section of the South grandstand.

STUDENT CONDUCT

As games are school functions, students are expected to exercise good judgement in their conduct and dress. **UNACCEPTABLE CONDUCT IS CAUSE FOR EJECTION FROM THE PREMISES.** Artificial noisemakers, such as air horns, bells, whistles, etc. are prohibited, as is the throwing of confetti, and/or other objects. Megaphones are to be used by the cheer staff only.

It is important that building **administrators** provide game supervision **in the stands** by promoting a safe enjoyable event for everyone. Please remind students to wear shirts, to observe the **stadium policy** of no body or face paint, no masks, and to observe good sportsmanship. If an issue with one of your students arises we will ask you to address it.

RESTROOMS

Restrooms are located inside the gym lobby, or in the portable toilet near the ticket booth. Locker rooms are for team use only. There are no public restrooms available in the locker rooms.

PRESS / TV / RADIO PASSES

May be obtained by contacting Game Manager.

SIGNS & SCHOOL BANNERS

NO signs other than the **OFFICIAL SCHOOL BANNER** will be allowed.

GAME PROGRAMS

Rogers High School will take responsibility for the production and/or sale of game programs. Rosters from WPAN will be used.

BAND & ROOTER BUSES

Due to the limited seating capacity, there will be no school band seating. **Rooter Buses** will be parked in the bus lane off 86th Ave. Students can walk to the main ticket gate for entry.

MEDICAL

There will be one Certified Athletic Trainer from ATI-PT available for both teams.

TIE GAMES-STATE TOURNAMENT

FIFA RULES will be used in all playoff games with WIAA published exceptions.

The method of breaking ties will be as follows:

Two (2) golden goal (5) minute overtimes. A coin toss shall be held prior to the first overtime as per Law 8. At the end of the first overtime period, teams shall change ends. If still tied at the end of the second overtime, penalty kicks will decide the outcome. The head referee shall choose the goal at which all of the kicks from the penalty mark shall be taken. Each coach will select five (5) players, including the goalkeeper, only players who are *on the field* of play at the end of the match are eligible take the kicks. A coin toss shall be held with the winning team having choice of kicking first or second. Teams will alternate kickers. There is no follow up on the kick. The defending team may change goalkeepers with an eligible player prior to each penalty kick. Following the five (5) kicks, the team scoring on the greatest number of kicks shall be declared the winner. If the score remains tied, each coach shall select five (5) different players than the first five to take kicks until one team has scored a goal more than the other from the same number of kicks.

OFFICIALS

Four (4) WOA certified soccer officials will be assigned to each match. Officials are selected by their association to work at this tournament and are assigned by the PCSRA. The officials will be head referee and two assistant referees along with a fourth official who acts as the timer and scorer. Official assessors may also be assigned.
