# 2019 YVIAA District 5 SCAC SOFTBALL TOURNAMENT MAY 16 & 18, 2019

# Time and Location:

Thursday, May 16<sup>th</sup> - Home site of high seeds (4 PM start) Saturday, May 18<sup>th</sup> - Connell High School - (10 AM start)

## Admission Prices:

- 1. Thursday, May 16<sup>th</sup> Adults \$7.00 Students \$5.00 (Grades 7-12 with ASB)
- 2. Saturday, May 18<sup>th</sup> Adults \$7.00 Students \$5.00 (Grades 7-12 with ASB)
- 3. Middle School and High Students without a valid ASB must pay adult prices
- 4. Honored citizens (seniors) will be admitted at student prices
- 5. School and League passes will not be honored
- 6. School Board passes will be honored
- 7. Various state level passes will be honored
- 8. The gate will be opened forty-five (45) minutes prior to the first game.

### **Conduct of Students, Community and School Personnel:**

- 1. An administrator (or designee) of each participating school is responsible for the conduct of his/her students and the spectators.
- 2. Each participating school is expected to provide staff supervision for its crowd.
- 3. A pass list must be emailed to the site managers (May 16<sup>th</sup> and May 18<sup>th</sup>) by Monday, May 13<sup>th</sup>.

### Pass List:

 The pass list is limited to ten (10) people. Bus drivers and trainers should be on this list but not included in the limit of ten (10). School board members do not need to be listed as they have their own district pass. Pass list must be sent to the site manager and posted in the drop box by Monday, May 13<sup>th</sup>. Stephen Pyeatt will be the site manager for the finals on May 18<sup>th</sup>.

#### **District Program:**

- 1. Cle Elum-Roslyn High School is responsible for a district final program.
- 2. Team rosters for the finals program are due by Monday, May 6<sup>th</sup> (9 AM).
- 3. Team rosters for the first-round games (and play in game) must be emailed to the site manager of the host schools by Monday, May 13<sup>th</sup>.

#### Home Team & Bench (Saturday, May 18th)

- 1. The site manager (or UIC) will meet with the head coaches to conduct a coin toss.
- 2. The team winning the coin toss will have the option of being the home or visitor.
- 3. The loser of the coin flip will choose the team bench.
- 4. Host teams for the Thursday games will be the home team and occupy their normal bench.

#### **Tournament:**

- 1. The tournament will be an eight team, double elimination tournament. The top 4 teams from the SCAC West, and top 4 teams from the SCAC East.
- 2. The top four (4) teams will qualify for the state tournament.
- 3. The winner of the tournament will be the District 5 champions.
- 4. The fifteen (15) run rule will be in effect.
- 5. Each team will be allowed a ten (10) minute warm-up prior to their first game.
- 6. Teams will be allowed a twenty (20) minute break between games, unless mutually agreed on a shorter period.

#### **Banners:**

Follow SCAC league guidelines.

#### **Radio Broadcasting:**

The charge for radio broadcasting is \$50 per day.

#### **Officials:**

The tournament manager will make specific game assignments from the block of officials assigned to the Saturday finals. Any change in assignment must have approval from both the site manager and the UIC. Host teams on May 16<sup>th</sup> will need to secure officials.

#### **Concessions:**

The Connell Boosters will supply concessions on May 18th.

# Game information for the games that are played on Saturday, May 18th

- The Home team will be the official book. The home team will be decided by a coin flip.
- Both teams need to call in results to their respective newspapers.
- The site manager will send the results to the league and district after the tournament.
- The entire team will be announced prior to the beginning of their first game (if PA is available). The pledge of allegiance will be announced or National Anthem will take place on filed #1 at the beginning of the 10 AM games only. Players on both fields need to be lined up on the fair/foul line in front of their respective dug-outs.
- The starting line ups will be announced prior to the beginning of the championship game. (If a PA is available).
- Games 5, 7, 9 and 12 will be played on the upper field (Field #1.) Games 6, 8, 10 and 11 will be played on the lower field (Field #2.) The tournament site manager may adjust the assigned field sites as needed.
- The winner of Game # 12 will be the district champion and will earn the district 5 # one seed to the state tournament. The loser of Game #12 will earn the district 5 # two seed to the state tournament. The winner of Game #11 will earn the district 5 # three seed to the state tournament. The loser of game #11 will get the district 5 # four seed to the state tournament.
- The fifteen (15) run rule will be in effect.
- The YVIAA will furnish game balls.
- The games committee will consist of the site manager, the UIC and a SCAC administrator selected by the site manager. The games committee will be adjusted by the site manager as needed in the event of a conflict of interest.
- Concessions will be available beginning at 9:30 AM.
- Two officials will be used for games 5 through 10. Three officials will be used for games 11, 12 and 13.
