<u>From Tacoma</u>: Take WA-16 W towards Bremerton, take State HWY 3 towards Poulsbo, continue on WA-3, and exit at WA-305 S (Poulsbo/Bainbridge Island), go 2.2 miles and turn left at NE Hostmark St. Proceed to 4 way stop, turn left, bus entrance is 2nd right. Park in gravel lot.

Field Surfaces

North Kitsap Stadium playing surface is synthetic grass by "Mondo-Turf." Soccer lines are marked in yellow.





Team Rosters

Rosters will be used for the pass gate, please make sure that all appropriate administrators and supervisors are listed on your roster which will be pulled from your WPA website at noon Friday, November 1. Please be sure on your WPA you include the following: 22 Players 6 Designated school personnel (coaches, managers, stats etc.) 1 Medical, 2 Supervisors

Administrator Supervision

Each school should have an administrator or designee on site to supervise and assist with crowd control. League supervision passes will be honored for the sub-district. Once on site the supervisors should check in with the Site Playoff Manager.

Game Ball

Three game balls (3) should be furnished by the Home Team

Team Benches

Both team benches will be located on the East side of the field. The Home Team bench will be located south of midfield (school building), and the Visiting Team bench will be located north of midfield (scoreboard).

Only participants (coaches, players, managers, athletic trainers, and cheer staff in uniform) will be allowed on the field. Each school will be allowed two field passes for student reporters or photographers.

<u>Uniforms</u>

The Home Team will wear dark-colored jerseys. The Visiting Team will wear white jerseys.

<u>Shoes</u>

Most players prefer to wear the same cleats they would use on a natural grass field.

Dressing Rooms

The locker rooms are located in the gymnasium on the right as you approach the stadium. The visiting team may use the Boys' locker room to change.

Locker rooms will be open at 11:00 AM for the game. Teams should plan to carry their bags to and from the field during their games.

Pre-game Schedule

Pre-game warm up will be a minimum of 20 minutes. During the warm up period referees will inspect equipment and meet with team captains. With one minute remaining in the warm up period (11:50 AM) teams should line up in front of their respective benches.

Player Introductions

The starting line up for the Visiting Team will be introduced first. Each player should proceed to mid field and form a single line to the south (scoreboard side of mid field) facing the main grandstand. They should remain in line while the Home Team is being introduced. When introduced, the Home Team will line up to the north of mid field. After the introductions, both teams should remain in line and turn to face the flag at the end of the stadium (south end) for the playing of the National Anthem or reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance. Upon completion teams should return to their respective benches.

Medical Services

NKHS Athletic Medicine staff will be onsite and available for all schools. Site will provide water and ice for each bench.

- Ticket price is good for admission on **specific day of game only**.
- Ticket Gates will open by 11:00 AM
- Please inform your students and parents ahead of time so they come prepared to pay an admission charge.
- Only players in uniform, <u>entering with team prior to their game</u>, will be admitted free entrance. Players will be expected to pay if not in uniform and/or not participating in game.
- <u>NO PARTICIPANT PASSES ARE ISSUED</u> Inform players they are to enter in <u>ONE GROUP</u> with a coach supervising. <u>28 MAXIMUM (AS PER WIAA GUIDELINES</u>) - to include <u>22 players</u> and <u>6 other designated</u> school personnel (coaches, managers, statisticians, etc), and 1 medical.
- **PRESS PASSES** will be accepted with proper identification.
- LEAGUE PASSES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED
- WASHINGTON STATE COACHES ASSOCIATION/WSSAAA PASSES Will be accepted with proper identification
- <u>SONG & CHEERLEADER PASSES</u> Cheerleaders and song leaders of participating schools will be admitted free, only if <u>IN UNIFORM AND ACCOMPANIED BY CHEER COACH</u>

Spectators and Crowd Control
