SITE INFORMATION / PLAYING SURFACE

Mt. Tahoma Stadium is located at 4634 S 74th St, Tacoma, WA 98409. The playing surface is an artificial turf with in-fill surface. Most players wear normal cleats used on a natural grass surface. (No metal cleats allowed)

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

From 1-5 Southbound: Take 1-5 South towards Portland. Take exit 129 for South 72nd Street. Keep right at the fork following signs to South 74th St. W. Take right onto S. 74th St. W. In 1.9 miles the Stadium will be on your left.

From 1-5 Northbound - Take 1-5 North towards Seattle. Take the Bridgeport Way exit, EXIT 125 toward Lakewood. Turn left onto Bridgeport Way for 1.4 miles and turn Right onto Lakewood Dr. SW. In 1.8 miles turn Right onto 74th St. W. In 0.3 miles the Stadium will be on your right.

TEAM BENCHES

Both teams will be seated on the visiting sideline of the stadium. The **Home** team school (bottom of the bracket) will use the south benches (south end). The **Visiting** team will use the benches on the north end (nearest the scoreboard). Coaches, players, managers, trainers, as well as cheerleaders will only be the only people allowed on the field or track.

SPECTATOR SEATING

WIAA tournament regulations state that a section of seating must be available for students who wish to stand for prolonged periods. (WIAA State Tournament Packet. PG. 6, Item M)

Only the home side seating areas of the of the stadium will be open for spectator seating.

GAME BALL

Game balls will be furnished by West Central District, 3 approved Baden tournament balls.

UNIFORMS

The home team will wear dark-colored jerseys and the visiting team will wear light-colored jerseys.

LOCKER ROOMS

Locker rooms are available for each team. The home locker room will be located on the Home (west) side of the Stadium and the visiting locker room will be located on the Visitors (east) side of the stadium. Locker rooms will be available 1 hour before the first game and after halftime of the previous game for the second game. Teams should carry their bags to and from the field during their game.

PRE-GAME SCHEDULE / HALFTIME

Pre-game warm-up will be a minimum of 20 minutes. Teams playing will be allowed onto the field no earlier 30 minutes before the first game of the day. Equipment inspection and team captain meeting will take place during the warm-up period. Halftime is 10 minutes. There will be no halftime entertainment.

INTRODUCTIONS OF TEAMS

All players will be introduced prior to the start of the game. We ask that each team line up on the sideline for introductions. The visiting team will be introduced first, followed by the home team. The National Anthem will take place after the introduction of the teams in the first game only. We ask that both teams in the first game remain on the sideline and face the flag located at the north end of the stadium.

GAMES COMMITTEE

Any problems that arise before or during the play should be brought to the attention of the head official. Any decision can then be appealed to the games committee. The games committee will be comprised of the playoff manager/site manager, head official, and a coach not involved in the game in question.

MEDICAL SERVICES

A trainer will be on site responding to the needs of athletes before, during and after the game. Ice will also be available to the teams after each game.

SIGNS / SCHOOL BANNERS / NOISE MAKERS

NO noise makers or signs (other than the **official school banner**) will be allowed
