Pre-Game Information

The visiting team will wear "whites" and use the team benches away from the scoreboard. Lockerooms are available for home/away teams. Do <u>NOT</u> leave anything in the lockerooms as other teams will be utilizing the space as well.
- 2) There is limited warm-up space in the North end zone for stretching, etc. 20 minutes will be allowed for warm-up before each game.
- 3) PLAYER INTRODUCTIONS: With 1 minute remaining on the clock, the horn will sound and we will begin introductions. The entire visiting team will be announced 1st, followed by the entire home team.

- 6) TEAM ROSTERS: Be sure your roster is accurate and ready for print on the WPA web-site for your school. Use the "District Program" PDF for your varsity with a photo (preferred)
- 7) FIELD SURFACE: The field is an artificial turf by FieldTurf installed in 2009. All soccer lines are marked in yellow.
- 8) FLAG SALUTE: There will be a flag salute before the 1st game each night
- 9) <u>Schedule</u> Ticket window will open at 4:30 on Thursday and Noon on Saturday.
- 10) Seating

All spectator seating will be in the main covered bleachers. The visiting side (team bench) seating will be CLOSED to spectators.

- 11) GAME BALLS: Baden balls will be provided by the West Central District.
- 12) Supervisors

Each school's supervisors will have primary responsibility for crowd control. They should be listed on the school's gate/pass list.

- 13) SPECTATOR SEATING: All spectators will be seated in the main/covered bleachers. Home spectators will sit closest to the scoreboard opposite their team bench, visitor spectators will be seated away from the scoreboard across from their team bench.
- 14) <u>Buses</u>

After drop off, please have buses park close to the MS gyms and AWAY from the stadium to leave fan parking closest to the stadium.

15) Locker-rooms

Do <u>NOT</u> leave any valuables in your locker-room. They will be used by ALL teams throughout the afternoon/evening.
