- Four team bracket tournament with a modified double elimination. Several games will be played prior to Saturday to determine final entries into the tournament:
 - 11:00 Game #3
 - 1:00 Game #4
 - 3:00 Game #5
 - 5:00 Game #6
 - 7:00 Game #7

PROGRAM ROSTER INFORMATION:

- You will need to complete your roster online at the WIAA website by Friday, November 1st. All rosters for the state program must be submitted on-line as per WIAA deadlines. Information regarding submitting pictures is available at the web address below:

TEAM ENTRY:

- Each team may have a roster of 14 players and 6 coaches/managers/statisticians. **Schools with a trainer/medical field are allowed one additional person on the bench. This person is NOT allowed to coach in any capacity.** No one other than those listed on the official roster will be allowed on the playing floor or team bench. All players/coaches and managers must enter together through main gym entrance.

PASSES

- League and season will NOT be honored. WSSAAA passes are accepted. WSCA passes are accepted. WCD Executive Board passes are accepted.

GATE PASS LIST FORM:

- **Administrators or Faculty only on the supervision gate pass list will be admitted for free.**
- This pass list must be e-mailed to Tyler Francis, Tournament Director, by **November 7**. Faculty supervisors whose names are on the gate list are asked to sit in the student section representing their school. Your help is important in maintaining a sportsmanlike atmosphere. Spectators wishing to leave and return will be stamped.

TEAM INTRODUCTIONS:

- Only introductions will be for the championship match on Saturday. All players and coaches for both teams will be introduced.

OFFICIALS & SCORERS:

- The Tournament Director will arrange for officials from officiating boards located in District 3. These officials will serve as game officials, line persons, and libero trackers.

GAME BALLS

- Game balls will be provided. They will be Baden balls.

COURT ASSIGNMENTS:

- Drawn by West Central District Volleyball Committee. The Tournament Director shall have authority to make adjustments as necessary.

PRE-MATCH WARM-UP

- The warm up will be the new Statewide 8-6-6 (8 min shared, 6 for home team and 6 for visiting). Teams should not arrive earlier than one hour prior to the first match. **Teams are not allowed on the court any earlier than 10:30.**

TOURNAMENT RULES:

- 2015 National Federation rules will be used with these exceptions:
- Each match will consist of 3 out of 5 sets. First four sets to 25 and fifth game to 15 with No Cap. Charles Wright will furnish warm-up balls. The tournament manager will furnish match balls that will be used in all contests.

DESIGNATION OF HOME TEAM:

- The home team will be the bottom team of each bracket.
- The home team warms up first.

TRAINING ROOM:

- Training room facility with ice will be available. You will need to provide your own athletic trainer and supplies.

LOCKER ROOMS:

- Assigned locker rooms will be available to share on Saturday.

TOWELS & PADLOCKS:

- Teams are to furnish their own towels and bring their own padlocks.

CHEERLEADERS:

- Admitted only in uniform and must remain in designated area.

FILMING:

- There are no electrical outlets available in bleachers. Bring plenty of battery power. Also, no flash photography will be allowed.

BUSES:

- Drop off participants in on the back side of Klahowya Secondary, please use the designated bus loop. Bus parking is located in the Bus loop area.

TEAM VANS:

- May park in the front parking lot area.

SPECTATOR PARKING:

- Parking will be available on the Klahowya Secondary School property. Handicap parking will be available in the front of the building.

GENERAL STATEMENTS:

- Bands will not be permitted to attend the event.
- The official school banner (made of cloth/vinyl) will be the only sign permitted.
- Any artificial noisemakers are prohibited and may be confiscated by tournament supervisors.
- The throwing of confetti or other materials is not allowed.

CONCESSIONS:

- Concessions will be sold in the concession area of the gym and there will be an officials/coaches hospitality room available.
