Roster and Eligibility

We will take rosters off the WPA site, **SO MAKE SURE THEY ARE ACCURATE**. You will need to complete your rosters on the WPA site by **Wednesday**, **November 13**.

Team Entry

Each team may have a roster of 14 players and 6 coaches/managers, for a total of 20. NO EXCEPTIONS. No one other than those listed on the official roster will be allowed on the playing floor or team bench. All players/coaches and managers **must enter together through main gym entrance**.

Passes

League and season passes **will not be honored**. WSSAAA, WSCA and WCD Executive Board passes are the only type that will be accepted.

Gate Pass List Form

ONLY Administrators or Faculty on the **WIAA** supervision gate pass list. Faculty supervisors whose names are on the gate list are asked to sit in the section representing their school.

Officials & Scorers

The Tournament Director will arrange for officials from the local officiating boards representing the teams within WCD3. These officials will serve as game officials and line judges. Assigning secretaries from each board represented determine official assignments. Scorers will be provided either by the Tournament Director, or the assigning secretaries from each board, as determined by the tournament director. *If a team uses a libero, that team will be responsible for providing a libero tracker. If BOTH teams use a libero then the designated home team will be responsible for providing the libero tracker.*

Training Room

Training room facility with ice will be available. A Seattle Children's Athletic Trainer will be on site. Please bring your own taping supplies, the site will not supply.

Locker Rooms

The girl's locker room will be available. Teams will need to provide their own locks and towels if needed.

Cheerleaders

Admitted only in uniform and must remain in the designated area. No more than 8 cheerleaders will be admitted in uniform and they will need to cheer from the spectator stands.

Filming

There are a limited number of electrical outlets available around the bleachers. Please bring plenty of battery power. No extension cords will be run across walkways. No cameras will be set up in the middle of the balcony.

Buses and Team Vans

Drop off participants in front of the Performing Arts Center (PAC) on Stadium Way.

DO NOT TAKE BUSES INTO THE ROUNDABOUT ON 2nd STREET

General Statements

- Bands will not be permitted at the tournament.
- The official school banner will be the only sign permitted
- ALL noisemakers are prohibited and may be confiscated by tournament supervisors
- The throwing of confetti or other materials is not allowed.

Concessions

Concessions will be sold in the lobby. NO OUTSIDE FOOD OR DRINK WILL BE PERMITTED.

Court Assignments:

Court assignments will be drawn by the Tournament Committee and the Tournament Director shall have the authority to adjust as necessary.

Game Balls

The tournament game balls will be furnished by Baden, the WCD's exclusive ball sponsor and will be the Baden Precision VX5EC.

Pre- Match Warm-up

Teams SHOULD NOT ARRIVE MORE THAN 45 minutes prior to the first match. The coin flip, 8 shared, 6-6 warm-up (serving included) procedure will be followed. Home warms up first. There will be a 20-minute minimum period between the end of the last match and the start of the warm-up period when teams are playing consecutive matches.

Tournament Rules:

2019 National Federation rules will be used with these exceptions:

- Each match will consist of 3 out of 5 games. First four games to 25 and fifth game to 15 with no cap.
- Each school will furnish their own warm-up balls.

Designation of Home Team

The home team will be the bottom team of each bracket and will warm up first.

Protests

WIAA District Volleyball Games Committee: Each Tournament Director shall appoint and name a Games Committee for all postseason contests. Duties of the Games Committee shall be as follows:

- Assist the Tournament Director as needed and be immediately available to him/her always during the event.
- Act as an arbitration board of dispute on questions or protests that might arise. The final decision will be the consensus of the Games Committee.
- Questions concerning infractions may be brought to the Games Committee by a coach or person in charge of a team, not by a contestant.
- The Games Committee shall be composed of no fewer than three, nor more than five members.
- The Games Committee members may not be involved with the game under dispute and should be composed of:
 - o Tournament Manager
 - o Coach, Athletic Director or School Administrator
 - Head Official
