W.I.A.A. Tournament Rules:

W.I.A.A. Tournament rules will apply. (I.e. Sportsmanship, signs/banners, noisemakers, confetti, admissions.) All NFHS football rules will be in effect.

Film Exchange

All participating schools will conduct a film exchange. The films will be of the two previous weeks. Consisting of the same quality each school uses for their own purposes.

Exchange will be set under agreements by the two schools.

Officials:

5 officials will be assigned for each game using the NWIAA Official Allotment Criteria/Formula for determining assignments. The home team is responsible for setting up officials.

Game Balls:

Game balls will be WIAA approved balls.

Emergency Procedure:

All games will be moved one day at a time for emergency cancellations. Site determination will be made and communicated to coaches at that time. In the event the tournament cannot be played due to weather or other conditions, the NWIAA emergency conditions policy will be followed to determine district representation.

Locker Rooms:

Locker Rooms will be available for visiting teams.

Tiebreaker Procedure:

NFHS "Kansas Tie Breaker" will be employed.

First round 25 yd. line

Second round 25 yd. line

Third round 10 yd. line.

Home Team – Visiting Team:

The team that is the higher seed will be the home team.

Players Bench:

Only uniformed players will be allowed on the team bench. As per the state guidelines, a maximum of Fifty (50) players and 16 (16) designated personnel (coaches, managers, statisticians and trainer) will be admitted. Sidelines and Team areas will be determined by Home Site. Teams will be placed in front of their student section if possible.

Student Rooting Sections - Each participating school will be assigned a rooting section by the game manager. Supervision of this section shall be the responsibility of the school administration of each school. Each participating school will be issued supervisory passes for this purpose.

Band Performances - The game manager shall designate one band to play the National Anthem.

Admission:**District 1 prices will be in effect**

Passes:

Lifetime WIAA, WSCA, and District One (**Brown**) Event Supervisory passes are the only valid passes for admission. The school name must be printed/typed on the pass.

Athletic Director, and Principal/Supervisor, participants, coaches, bus/van driver(s) and scorekeeper must be included on the participant's sheet provided. This list needs to be completed and returned to the Home Team High School Athletic Office by NOV. 4 2019

Press:

Members of the working media and press photographers who wish to cover the event will be admitted, but need to check-in at the pass gate with appropriate credentials.

Supervisors:

Each participating school will need to provide three (3) school supervisor/designees for crowd control.
